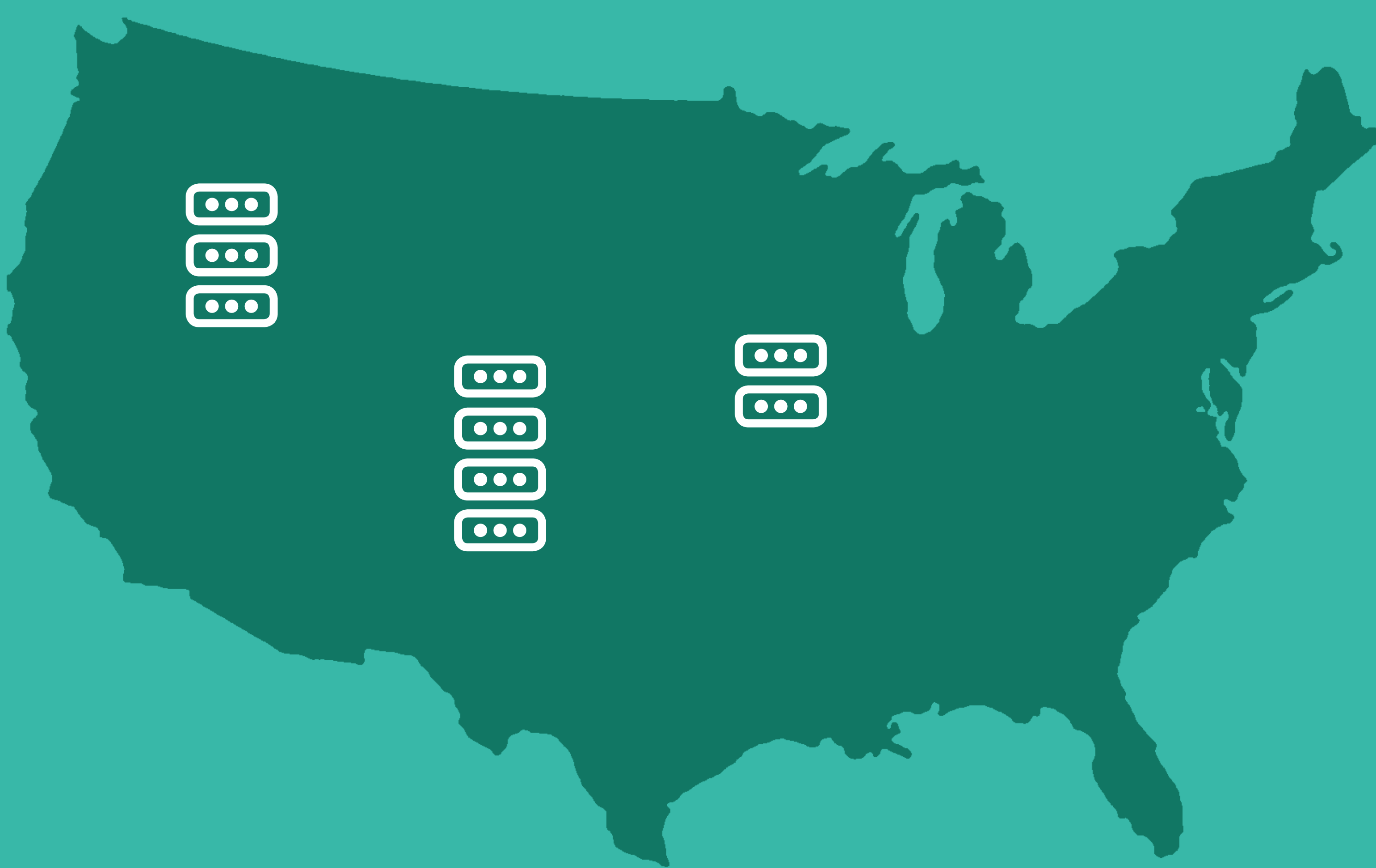




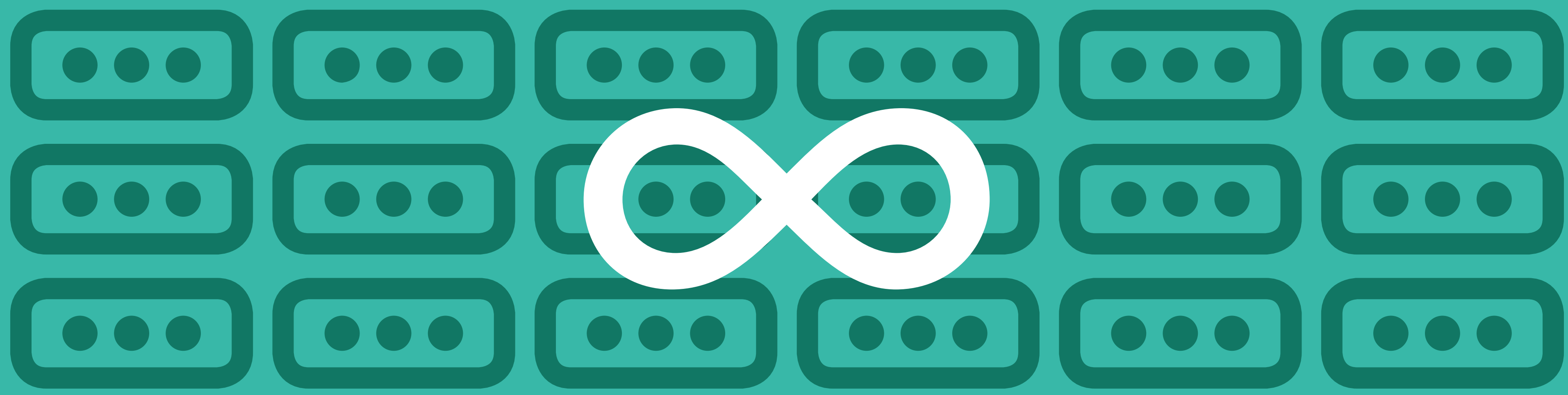
FaceApp fact sheet



FaceApp is a Russian startup based in St. Petersburg.¹



The company uses Google and Amazon servers based in America, which means the data is stored and remains in America.²



Photos taken using the app are stored in the cloud indefinitely by FaceApp.³



Yaroslav Goncharov, CEO of FaceApp, says that the only photos taken to the cloud for processing are the exact photos the user selects and most photos are deleted after 48 hours.⁴



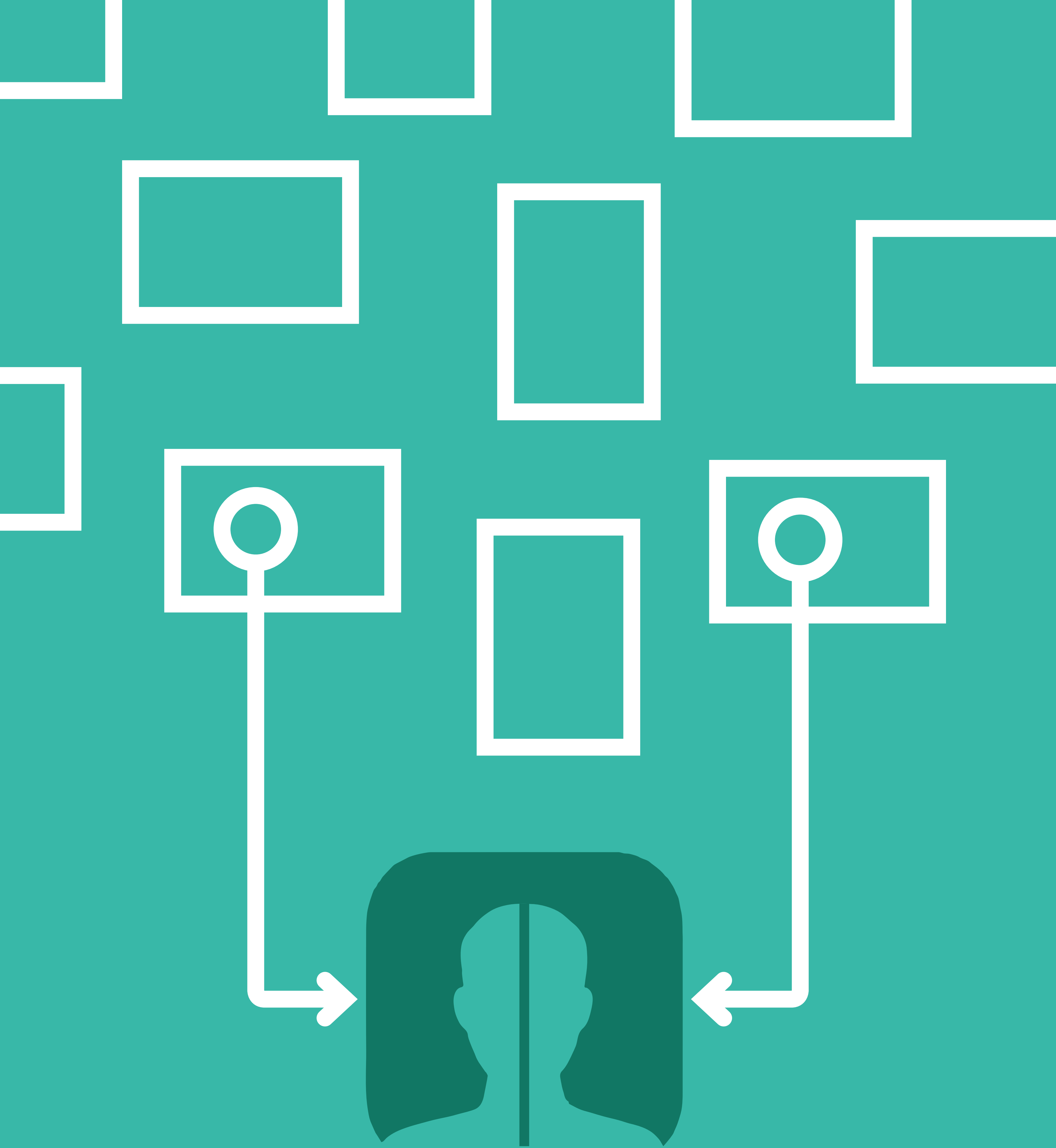
Android and iOS devices allow you to remove permissions granted to any app. We recommend removing these permissions when you are finished using any app that you don't trust.
